	Leave a house key with a neighbor or friend in case of an emergency.
	Advise post office to hold your mail.
	Unplug electric appliances.
	Shut off gas, electricity and water, if practical.

	Check tires (including the spare) and battery before leaving. (If replacement seems necessary, the cost is likely to be less from your local supplier than it might be on the road.)
	Oil level, filters and lubrication should be checked prior to departure and on the road if your engine gauges or auto mobile computer indicate the need.
	Make sure you have car tools including a properly operating jack, lug wrench, screwdriver, pliers, flashlight and work cloth.
	Take along a first aid kit.
	Be sure your vehicle registration and inspection is current and carry your driver's license, proof of insurance and download the free Coach-Net mobile app
